BRIMS invites you to be a part of the seventeenth annual **BRIMS Regional Bridge Building Championships**. Through the sponsorship of **Scott & Murphy, Inc., Stupp Bridge Company**, and the **WKU Dept. of Architectural & Manufacturing Sciences** we are proud to once again provide one of the best regional contests in the nation. The contest will be held on Saturday, March 10, 2012 at Stupp Bridge Company, 445 Century St., Bowling Green, KY.

As the official regional affiliation for the International Bridge Building Contest, our top two finishers in the high school division will qualify for the International competition in May. We will pay expenses for those two students and their chaperones to travel to Las Vegas, NV for the competition. The top **ten** finishers in each division of the Regional competition will receive trophies for their efforts. In addition, the top **two** schools in each division with the highest combined score for their top five finishers will receive a beautiful plaque. In addition, awards will be given for Architectural Design. A panel of four judges will judge the bridges on architectural elegance and innovative and ingenious form. Bridges must be within specifications of the Bridge Building Contest rules. Two awards will be given in each division.
